DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

[1] In decision [2014] NZARLA 364 dated 16 June 2014, we made an order to suspend an on-licence in respect of premises situated at 62 Vickerman Street, Nelson, known as "Anchor Bar & Grill". The term of suspension was due to commence on Wednesday 2 July 2014.

[2] The respondent has approached our Secretary with a request that the suspension be postponed because the business is to host a pre-booked function on that date. Sergeant Savage has indicated that he has no opposition to the request.

[3] In the circumstances we agree to rehear the matter on the papers pursuant to s.201(4) and we grant the application. Accordingly we make the following amended order:

On-licence number 050/ON/161/05, issued to Double B Hospitality Limited, is suspended for 48 hours from 8.00 am on Wednesday 9 July 2014.

[4] In all other respects the decision remains unaltered.
