MEMORANDUM-DIRECTIONS OF JUDGE C T COXHEAD

12 December 2017

1. This memorandum-directions concerns a request from the claimant for the Motukawanui claim (Wai 234) that a document be added to the record of inquiry in stage 2 of the Te Paparahi o Te Raki inquiry (Wai 1040) inquiry.

Request by claimant to file submissions and evidence for Wai 234

2. Tribunal staff were handed a document at hearing week 25 at Otangaroa Marae, Whangaroa, by Hemi-Rua Rapata, the claimant for the Motukawanui claim (Wai 234). The Tribunal has since been contacted by Mr Rapata requesting that this document be added to the record of inquiry for Wai 1040.
3. The first four pages of the document contain submissions, while the following 12 pages contain primary source evidence, some of which duplicates that filed with Mr Rapata's and Steven Samuels's #AA161(a) brief of evidence. As I have previously noted (Wai #2.6.264), closing submissions are a time for legal submissions and not evidence. Accordingly, the Registrar is to add the first four pages of the document to the Wai 1040 record of inquiry as closing submissions for Wai 234.

The Registrar is to send this direction to all those on the notification list for Wai 1040, the Te Paparahi o Te Raki inquiry.
