Extension request to file Wai 1536 claim-specific reply submissions

1. This memorandum-directions addresses the seventh extension request to file the claim-specific submissions in reply to Crown closing submissions on behalf of Dr Mary-Anne Tapu Baker for the Descendants of Te Kemara uri o Maikuku rāua ko Hua (Wai 1536) claim.
2. On 14 November 2018, counsel Tavake Afeaki, James Lewis and Siaoisi Tofi sought one further extension to file the claim-specific reply for the Wai 1536 claim. Counsel advise they need more time to confirm instructions due to further unexpected events, duties and a heavy caseload. Counsel seek to file by 10 December 2018.
3. This is the seventh such extension request from counsel to file reply closings for the Wai 1536 claim. They were originally due in August 2018.
4. Counsel have until **5pm, Friday 30 November 2018** to file this reply.
5. Counsel are advised this is the last and final extension to be granted for this matter.
