Report release timetable

1. In memorandum-directions dated 23 April 2018, I confirmed the preliminary report (the report) release timetable for reporting on claims in the Te Rohe Pōtae District Inquiry (Wai 898, #2.7.18).
2. The Tribunal released Part 1 and 2 of the report in September 2018. Part 3 was due to be released in December 2018. Due to the delay in releasing Parts 1 and 2, and the availability of Tribunal resources, Part 3 will now be released in mid-April 2019.
3. We regret the delay in releasing the next tranche of the report, however, this was unavoidable and we wish to produce the best result for all parties.

Chief Historian – Cathy Marr

4. During the hearings phase of the inquiry, Cathy Marr presented evidence on nineteenth century issues and was therefore not involved in this part of the report. Given that Ms Marr was not involved in twentieth century matters during the hearings, she has now resumed her Chief Historian duties for this report.
