MEMORANDUM-DIRECTIONS OF JUDGE C T COXHEAD

12 December 2018

Wai 1536 claim-specific reply submissions

1. As directed on 30 November 2018, counsel Tavake Afeaki and Siaosi Tofi filed a 40-page claim-specific reply to Crown closing submissions on behalf of Dr Mary-Anne Tapu Baker for the Descendants of Te Kemara uri o Maikuku rāua ko Hua (Wai 1536) claim.
2. Counsel also sought leave for the Tribunal to take 'judicial notice' of an accompanying 89-page appendix which they described as containing further submissions made by the claimant Dr Mary-Anne Baker with supplementary documents.
3. Leave is granted to file the Wai 1536 claim-specific reply.
4. I decline leave sought to file the accompanying appendix as it is more in the nature of evidence and the deadline for new evidence for this inquiry has long past.
