1. This Memorandum of Counsel is filed on behalf of Wai 2236, a claim originally filed by Awhina Muriwai Hill on behalf of herself and the descendants of Priscilla Muriwai Dennison.

Addition of named claimants

2. Counsel has been instructed that the named claimant for Wai 2236, Mrs Awhina Hill, has passed away.
3. Accordingly, the whanau have agreed to add Peter Hill as named claimant for this claim and seek the Waitangi Tribunal amend their records to reflect this change.

Legal Counsel

4. The Claimant confirms Eve Rongo of Oranganui Legal as legal counsel for this claim.

7. The Wai 2236 claim has been correctly identified as a claim eligible to participate in the Inquiry into Remaining Historical Claims: Southern North Island and South Island Claims.¹

8. The Claimant confirms the Wai 2236 claim is eligible to participate in this process as the claim:
 - (a) is not participating in a current Waitangi Tribunal inquiry or been heard in previous Waitangi Tribunal inquiries;

 - (b) has not been settled by legislation; and

 - (c) is not included in the mandates of groups that have agreed to terms of negotiation with the Crown for a settlement of their historical claims.
