1 Purpose

In his memorandum-directions of 5 May 2009 (Wai 898 #2.5.36), Judge Ambler asked Tribunal and Crown Forestry Rental Trust (CFRT) staff to file quarterly updates on research progress. This is the 17th update from Tribunal staff.

2 Completed research
