

Appendix One: Confirmed forthcoming inquiry filing dates

As per the Tribunal's *Guide to Practice and Procedure* at 4.6, unless a different time is stated below, all documents are to be filed in the Tribunal's Registry by 12 noon on the day that they are due.

Date	Filing
28 February 2020	Chief Historian Review of research relating to Māori with disabilities will be completed
End of February 2020	Tribunal to complete aggregation and consolidation for claims relating to disability and advise outcome
26 March 2020	Crown to file statement of response, and any concessions they wish to make, in relation to the disability claims
9 April 2020	Claimant and Crown counsel to file (preferably jointly) agreed inquiry timetable for the stage two inquiry into disability issues, providing: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • identification of co-ordinating counsel; • arrangements for the filing of a joint draft agreed statement of issues; • a suggested discovery process; • a timetable for the filing of witness statements; • estimation of the number of hearing weeks required; • a hearing timetable; and • identification of suitable locations for hearing
29 April 2020	Claimant and Crown counsel to file any further suggestions regarding the interlocutory programme for the remainder of the stage two inquiry
1 June 2020	Crown and claimant counsel to report back on progress concerning the possibility of a stand-alone Māori health authority and funding issues (arising from the interim recommendations of the stage one report)
