EXTENSION REQUESTS**



1. In memorandum-directions dated 19 May 2020, I gave parties the opportunity to file submissions in writing following the judicial conference convened on 27 May 2020 (Wai 2700, #2.5.20). These were due to be filed by 3 June 2020.
2. In memorandum-directions dated 3 June 2020, I then granted a blanket extension for parties to file by midday, 5 June 2020 (Wai 2700, #2.5.21).
3. On 3 June 2020, Hemi Te Nahu filed a memorandum seeking a further extension until Tuesday, 9 June 2020 (Wai 2700, #3.1.217). Mr Te Nahu's submissions were received on 9 June 2020 (Wai 2700, #3.1.226). Leave is granted for these submissions to be filed out of time.
4. On 5 June 2020, Janet Mason also filed a memorandum seeking an extension to file by close of business on Wednesday, 10 June 2020 (Wai 2700, #3.1.218).
5. All parties are granted leave to file any remaining submissions by **5pm, Wednesday 10 June 2020**. No further extensions will be granted.
