REQUEST**



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1. In memorandum-directions dated 19 May 2020, I gave parties the opportunity to file submissions in writing following the judicial conference convened on 27 May 2020 (Wai 2700, #2.5.20). These were due to be filed by 3 June 2020.
2. On 2 June 2020, Season-Mary Downs and Heather Jamieson filed a memorandum seeking an extension to file submissions by 5 June 2020 (Wai 2700, #3.1.214). They advised claimant counsel held a teleconference on 2 June 2020 to discuss matters raised at the judicial conference and that a collective response is being drafted, however more time is needed to coordinate the filing of this joint memorandum.
3. The leave sought is granted and counsel are to file by **midday, Friday 5 June 2020**. For the avoidance of doubt, this extension applies to all parties.

The Registrar is directed to send a copy of this direction to counsel for the claimants, Crown counsel and all those on the distribution list for Wai 2700, the Kaupapa Inquiry into claims concerning Mana Wāhine.
