**MEMORANDUM-DIRECTIONS OF CHIEF JUDGE ISAAC GRANTING
EXTENSION FOR FILING FEEDBACK ON CLAIM ASSESSMENTS**

18 October 2022

Descendants of Priscilla Muriwai Dennison (Wai 2236) claimants request extension

1. On 20 September 2022, I granted a blanket extension for claimant feedback on the five claim assessments (released on 7 August 2022) to be submitted by 18 October 2022. The Crown was accordingly directed to reply by 15 November 2022 (Wai 2800, #2.5.10).
2. On 12 October 2022, Eve Rongo, counsel for the Descendants of Priscilla Muriwai Dennison (Wai 2236) claim sought a week's extension until 25 October 2022 to provide feedback on the Wai 2236 claim assessment (Wai 2800, #3.1.23). Counsel advised that the claimants are in a period of mourning following an unexpected death in the whānau in Australia and would look to finalise instructions upon their return on 21 October 2022.
3. The extension sought is granted.
4. Counsel for the Wai 2236 claim is directed to file the feedback on the claim assessments by **5pm, Tuesday 25 October 2022**. Should it be required, the Crown is granted a corresponding one-week extension to **5pm, Tuesday 22 November 2022** to submit a reply to the Wai 2236 feedback received.
