MEMORANDUM-DIRECTIONS OF JUDGE C T COXHEAD

15 February 2023

Request for process to advise corrections to Tribunal's pre-publication report

1. This memorandum-directions responds to a request for a process for claimants to submit suggested corrections regarding the pre-publication version of part 1 of *Tino Rangatiratanga me te Kāwanatanga: The Report on Stage 2 of the Te Paparahi o Te Raki Inquiry*, released on 23 December 2022.
2. On 3 February 2023, counsel Season-Mary Downs and Tatijana Simon-Larsen advised the following claimant groups wished to thank the Tribunal for the release of the pre-publication of Part 1 of the Wai 1040 Tribunal's report on the claims before it for stage 2 of the Te Paparahi o Te Raki inquiry (Wai 1040, #3.4.55):
 - (a) Wai 49/682 – Ngāti Hine;
 - (b) Wai 1464/1546 – Te Kapotai;
 - (c) Wai 68 – Hira Hunapo;
 - (d) Wai 149 – Te Rau Moetahi Hoterene;
 - (e) Wai 455 – Riwi Niha;
 - (f) Wai 565 – Pari Peihopa;
 - (g) Wai 1440 – Phillip Bristow for Ngāti Manu;
 - (h) Wai 1445 – Phillip Bristow for Te Roroa;
 - (i) Wai 1518 – Yvette Puru;
 - (j) Wai 1520 – Pierre Lyndon;
 - (k) Wai 1527 – Ataiti Te Rehu (Hoterene) Armstrong;
 - (l) Wai 1551 – Elizabeth Boutet;
 - (m) Wai 1710 – Sadie McGee;
 - (n) Wai 1972 – Wattie Cooper; and
 - (o) Wai 2182 – Kararaina Ihapera Tohu.
3. Counsel advised they had identified a number of typographical and referencing errors in the pre-publication report and seek an opportunity to submit suggested corrections to the Tribunal prior to the report's finalisation. Counsel said that the nature of corrections sought are typographical and referencing errors only and are 'not to the substance' of the report (Wai 1040, #3.4.55 at [4]). Counsel suggest a correction process similar to that used for submitting hearing transcript corrections.
4. Counsel add that they are liaising with claimants regarding the formal handover of the final report and seek to be able to submit suggested corrections within a timeframe that aligns with finalising the pre-publication report for the formal handover.

Decision

5. I grant this request and invite all parties in the inquiry to submit any proposed revisions concerning typographical and referencing errors only by **5pm, Friday, 31 March 2023**. The Tribunal will consider parties' submissions and incorporate any resulting changes into the final published version of the report. Substantive findings will not be altered.

The Registrar is to send this direction to all those on the notification list for Wai 1040, the Te Paparahi o Te Raki inquiry.
