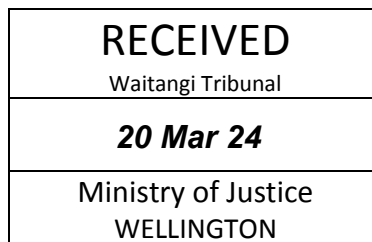



MAY IT PLEASE THE TRIBUNAL

- 1 Counsel previously acted for Charles Tawhiao (**Mr Tawhiao**), Chairperson of the Ngāi Te Rangī Settlement Trust (the **Trust**), on behalf of the Trust and its Māori beneficiaries, the iwi of Ngāi Te Rangī, in this matter.
- 2 Counsel files this memorandum to notify the Tribunal that its instructions have been ended in this matter and to seek leave to withdraw.
- 3 Counsel has not been able to contact Mr Tawhiao or the Trust, following the termination of instructions, regarding the appointment of alternative representation. The issuing of the Memorandum-directions of Judge Williams, dated 15 March, regarding a judicial conference and other deadlines has made this notification of the Tribunal and other parties urgent.
