MEMORANDUM-DIRECTIONS OF JUDGE REEVES EXTENDING
COMMISSIONED RESEARCH**30 Hōngongoi 2024

1. On 20 March 2023, I commissioned Associate Professor Rachel Wolfgramm to prepare a historical overview report on the period 1840 to 1950, focusing on the recognition of wāhine Māori roles, status, and knowledge for the Mana Wāhine Kaupapa Inquiry (Wai 2700, #2.3.5 at [1]).
2. The deadline for the filing of this commissioned report was 31 July 2024 (Wai 2700, #2.3.5 at [5]).
3. I am advised that the researcher requires an extension of time to complete the final revisions and to file the report. I have decided to extend the commission accordingly.
