

MEMORANDUM-DIRECTIONS OF JUDGE REEVES
RELEASING COMMISSIONED RESEARCH2 Hereturikōkā 2024

1. Pursuant to clause 5A of the second schedule of the Treaty of Waitangi Act 1975, Professor Huia Jahnke was commissioned on 4 July 2023 to prepare a report on contemporary education and employment issues for wāhine Māori between 1990 and 2020 for the Mana Wāhine Kaupapa Inquiry (Wai 2700, #2.3.7 at [1]).
2. The deadline for the filing of this commissioned report was 1 July 2024 (Wai 2700, #2.3.7 at [5]).
3. In my memorandum-directions of 1 July 2024, I extended this commission and directed that the commissioned report should be filed by 2 August 2024 (Wai 2700, #2.3.16 at [4]).
4. The report has been received and the Registrar is now directed to enter it on the Wai 2700 Record of Inquiry. The title of the report is:

*'Toitū te Mana Wāhine
Contemporary Employment and Education Issues for Wāhine Māori:
Equity and Disparities from 1990 to 2020'*
