MEMORANDUM-DIRECTIONS OF JUDGE REEVES EXTENDING
COMMISSIONED RESEARCH

1. On 21 November 2022, I commissioned Helena Rattray-Te Mana to prepare a report on contemporary justice issues for wāhine Māori from 1990 to 2020 for the Mana Wāhine Kaupapa Inquiry (Wai 2700, #2.3.2 at [1]).
2. Following a request for further time, the commission was extended, and I confirmed that the final report would be filed on 23 August 2024 (Wai 2700, #2.3.10 at [6]–[9]).
3. I am advised that the researcher requires a further extension to complete the final revisions and file the report. I have decided to extend the commission accordingly.
4. The commission will now end on **10 September 2024**, at which time one copy of the final report must be submitted to the Registrar for filing in unbound form, together with indexed copies of any supporting documents or transcripts. An electronic copy of the report and supporting documentation should also be provided in Word and PDF file format.
