
1. Pursuant to clause 5A of the second schedule of the Treaty of Waitangi Act 1975, Associate Professor Rachel Wolfgramm was commissioned on 20 March 2023 to prepare a report on the period 1840 to 1950, focusing on the recognition of wāhine Māori roles, status, and knowledge for the Mana Wāhine Kaupapa Inquiry (Wai 2700, #2.3.5 at [1]).
2. In my memorandum-directions of 30 July 2024, I granted an extension for this commission (Wai 2700, #2.3.17). The final commissioned report was to be filed by 18 October 2024.
3. The report has been received and the Registrar is now directed to enter it on to the Wai 2700 Record of Inquiry. The title of the report is:

'Mana Wāhine Māori i Ngā Wā ō Mua: The impacts of Crown legislation, policy and practices on the rangatiratanga, status and roles of wāhine Māori c.1840-1950.'
