KIA WHAKAAE MAI E TE TARAIPUNARA

1. This Memorandum of Counsel is filed in relation to the priority inquiry into the disestablishment of Te Aka Whai Ora on behalf of the following claims:

(a) Wai 1341, a claim by Nora Rameka on behalf of Te Ruunanga o Ngaati Reehia representing Ngaati Reehia hapuu; and

(b) Wai 2476, a claim by Bryar Te Hira and her whaanau.

(“the Claimants”)

2. By way of Memorandum-Directions dated 1 October 2024, his Honour Judge Stone directed that claimant and interested party closing submissions be filed by 5pm, Monday 14 October 2024.¹

3. Due to competing deadlines and the need to confirm instructions with our respective clients on the joint closing submissions, despite best efforts, Counsel regrettably are unable to finalise and file closing submissions by the deadline specified above.

4. Accordingly, Counsel respectfully seek a short extension until **5pm, Tuesday 15 October 2024** to finalise and file closing submissions for this matter.

5. Counsel submit that little to no prejudice will accrue to any other party should the extension be granted as sought.
