MAY IT PLEASE THE TRIBUNAL:

1. This memorandum of co-ordinating counsel is filed further to joint memorandum filed on Friday 8 November 2024, attaching time requests and topic indications for hearing week 3 (the “**joint memorandum**”).
2. In the joint memorandum, we indicated that not all counsel had been able to provide their topic indications as at late Friday and that an updated Appendix B including all topic indications would therefore be provided as soon as possible on Monday 11 November.¹
3. Counsel now attaches an updated spreadsheet, which is intended to replace the **Appendix B** that was filed on Friday 8 November. The only changes are as follows:
 - (a) Additional topic indications have been provided by three counsel;² and
 - (b) Mahoney Horner’s time estimate for cross-examination of Luiten has increased from 5 to 15 minutes.
