**MAY IT PLEASE THE TRIBUNAL**

1. This memorandum of counsel is filed on behalf of Takerei Peck, a named claimant for Te Whānau a Mōkōmōko Wai 203, being a claim for and on behalf of the descendants of the Rangatira Mōkōmōko.
2. By way of memorandum dated 10 February 2025, counsel filed the brief of evidence of Jardyn Takerei Peck and noted that permission was being sought to file the second video attachment to Mr Peck's evidence.<sup>1</sup>
3. Counsel have now obtained the necessary permission from TVNZ. Accordingly, we **attach** for filing the video entitled 'Kōrero ā nga pākeke' referred to as TP-1 in the brief of evidence of Mr Peck.<sup>2</sup> In accordance with the Guide to practice and procedure the video is in the recognised MP4 video format and filed by way of electronic [link](#).
4. The Kōrero ā nga pākeke video is entirely in Te Reo Māori and the claimants will not be providing their own English translation. As such, the simultaneous translation services of the Tribunal will be relied on during the hearing.
5. Counsel also advise the video evidence will not be played in full during the hearing, rather sections of the footage will be played during Mr Peck's presentation of evidence.
