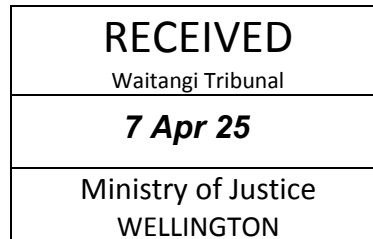

**MAY IT PLEASE THE TRIBUNAL:**

1. This Memorandum of Counsel is filed on behalf of Tāwhirimātea Williams and the Wai 1795 claim, a claim on behalf of himself and his whānau and for the benefit of the hapū of Ngāti Ruatakena (the **Claimants**).
2. By Memorandum-Directions dated 3 December 2024, her Honour Judge Mullins directed parties seeking to participate in the inquiry to file new or amended statements of claim by 5pm, Monday 7 April 2025.<sup>1</sup>
3. Counsel is working to co-ordinate with the Claimants to finalise the Amended Statement of Claim. Unfortunately, Counsel has been unable to meet with our client to confirm instructions. Counsel therefore respectfully seeks an extension until 5pm Monday, 14 April 2025.
