

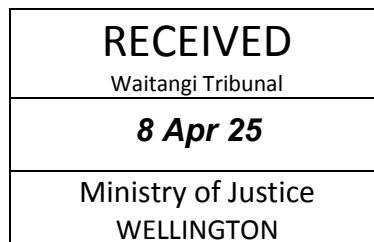

MAY IT PLEASE THE TRIBUNAL:

1. This memorandum of counsel is filed on behalf of Tiaki Grant-Mackie as named claimant for the Wai 3243 claim. (“the Claimant”).
2. Counsel have been instructed to act for the Claimant in the Education and Services Outcomes Inquiry. We note that by memorandum directions dated 3 November 2024, her Honour Judge Mullins directed for new statements of claim to be filed in this inquiry by Monday 7 April 2025.¹
3. As counsel only recently confirmed instructions regarding the Claimant’s participation, we respectfully seek a short extension until 14 April 2025, to file an amended Wai 3243 statement of claim for amalgamation into this Inquiry.
4. Broadly, the Claimant has concerns she wishes to raise with the Tribunal regarding tamariki Māori with autism in the public-school system. Counsel consider these issues relevant to the Education Inquiry and confirm they have not yet been heard.
5. We submit no party will incur prejudice should the sought extension be granted.
