

MEMORANDUM-DIRECTIONS OF THE DEPUTY CHAIRPERSON

1. On 3 June 2025, the Tribunal received a statement of claim from Cale Wairepo regarding quarrying activity on and around Te Weraiti Maunga and Mangapiko Awa (Wai 3511, #1.1.1).
2. On 1 July 2025, the Tribunal received an application for urgent hearing in relation to this claim (Wai 3511, #3.1.1). Further documents in support of the application were received on 14 and 18 July 2025 (Wai 3511, #3.1.1(a), #3.1.1(b), #A1 & #A2).
3. I now direct the Crown and any interested parties to respond to the application for an urgent hearing by no later than **midday, Wednesday 6 August 2025**.
4. I also direct the applicant to file submissions in reply to those of the Crown and interested parties by no later than **midday, Wednesday 20 August 2025**. This reply is to be confined to reply to what has been said in terms of paragraph [2] above. It is not a further opportunity nor is it proper to replead or repeat the claim. Assertions are not to be made, except on matters raised by the Crown or the opposing parties.
5. Failure to comply may result in the rejection of documents or significant delay in deciding whether or not to grant urgency.

The Registrar is to send a copy of this direction to the applicant, Crown counsel and those on the notification list for Wai 3511, the Te Weraiti and Mangapiko (Wairepo) claim.
