The Registrar is directed to add to Wai 2874 an amended statement of claim received on 4 April 2025 and to record its date of receipt in the register of claims.


This amendment seeks to further particularise the original statement of claim for Wai 2874, specifically in relation to the role of wāhine Māori, te whare o te tangata, hierarchical perceptions of race, the punitive approach and systemic biases disproportionately affecting wāhine Māori, urbanisation, and the rise in Māori incarceration rates.

The amendment is to be entered on Wai 2874, the Mana Wāhine (Women in Gangs) claim, as document #1.1.1(a).

- Wai 2700, the Mana Wāhine Kaupapa Inquiry.
