MEMORANDUM-DIRECTIONS OF TRIBUNAL

The claim concerns legislation, and acts, omissions, policies and practices of the Crown, which the claimants allege have prejudicially affected the tribal estate of Ngai Tamarawaho.

The claim will be heard with other claims grouped for inquiry with Wai 215, the Tauranga/Western Bay of Plenty claims. Accordingly, the Registrar is directed to consolidate the record of inquiry for this claim with the Wai 215 consolidated record of inquiry. The Tribunal will consider research requirements for this claim and a member of the Tribunal's staff will liaise with the claimant about the matter.

The claimant may amend the claim at a later stage, if necessary.
