(Taylor) claim**MEMORANDUM-DIRECTIONS OF THE PRESIDING OFFICER**

The Registrar is directed to add to Wai 2729 an amended statement of claim received on 27 February 2026 and to record its date of receipt in the register of claims.

This amendment seeks to replace the amended statements of claim for Wai 2729 regarding mana wahine, recorded as documents #1.1.1(a) and #1.1.1(c).

The amendment particularises the claim, specifically in relation to the exclusion and marginalisation of wāhine Māori from public health policy, sexual harm and culturally appropriate sexual harm support services, and family violence.


The amendment also adds a variety of further relief, including recommendations related to family violence prevention and response services.

The amendment is to be entered on Wai 2729, the Mental Health Services (Taylor) claim, as document #1.1.1(d).

- Wai 2729, the Mental Health Services (Taylor) claim; and
- Wai 2700, the Mana Wahine kaupapa inquiry.
