1 Reinstatement of claimant

- 1.1 The Wai 538 claim was originally lodged by Mrs Ivy Waitangi Kapua on behalf of the Ngati Whaita Hapu of Ongaroto Marae on 5 August 1995.
- 1.2 In an amendment to the statement of claim dated 13 December 1997, authority for the claim was transferred to the Ngati Whaita Trust Board, whose Chairman, Mr Te Pare Kauhi Joseph was added as a named claimant for the claim.
- 1.3 It was never intended that Mrs Kapua would be removed as a named claimant and replaced by Mr Joseph. **Attached** to this memorandum is a letter signed by Mr Joseph and Mrs Kapua, asking that **Mrs Ivy Waitangi Kapua** be reinstated as one of the named claimants for this claim, together with Mr Joseph.


