Geothermal Resources Claim**MEMORANDUM-DIRECTIONS OF THE CHAIRPERSON**

1. On 28 March 2012 the Tribunal issued its decision to grant an urgent hearing of the Wai 2357 and Wai 2358 claims (Wai 2357, #2.5.13; Wai 2358, #2.5.13). This included an appendix listing the interested parties that had been involved in the proceedings leading to the decision.
2. The Tribunal has received several memoranda from counsel advising of interested parties that had participated in the proceedings but were omitted from this appendix (Wai 2357 & Wai 2358, #3.1.67; #3.1.68; #3.1.69).
3. This direction notifies parties that a further revised list of interested parties will be issued by the Tribunal following the judicial conference currently scheduled for Friday 20 April 2012.
4. In Ms Moana Sinclair's memorandum (Wai 2357, #3.1.68; Wai 2358, #3.1.68), she refers to a submission filed on 9 March 2012 seeking leave for her clients to be added as interested parties. I note that this was not received by the Tribunal until 13 March 2012. Due to a clerical error this was not placed on the records of inquiry for the Wai 2357 and Wai 2358 claims. The Registrar is directed to add Ms Sinclair's 13 March 2012 submission to these records.
