Being descendants of Rangituhia, Rangiteauria and Uenukumanawawiri, claim to be prejudicially affected by the acquisition of the following Maori Land, by the Crown. Being lands owned by the above Tribes, and being adversely affected by the Crown's actions, and that we claim to:

1. The area classified Part 8. or Ruapehu Survey District XI. (Ref. Plan 1), within the boundary of the Tongariro National Park. This has a total area of 5,180 acres and was originally constituted Tongariro National Park by the Tongariro National Park Act 1894 and re - constituted by the National Parks Act 1952. This area was not processed through the Maori Land Acts and therefore still remains Maori Customary Land.

We, on behalf of its beneficiary owners and their Sub Tribes, claim that the acquisition of all the aforesaid land in schedule (1) by the Crown in the past has prejudicially and materially, and is totally inconsistent with the spirit of the Treaty of Waitangi. Accordingly the Waitangi Tribunal is asked to recommend that all the aforesaid land in schedule (1) be returned to the original owners or their descendants, accordingly to the Principles of the Treaty of Waitangi.

We, invite the Tribunal to hear this claim at Maungarongo Marae Ohakune.

All correspondence is to be forwarded to R. Gray R.D.1. Taihape.

We have also a pending claim before the Tribunal in Wai.151.

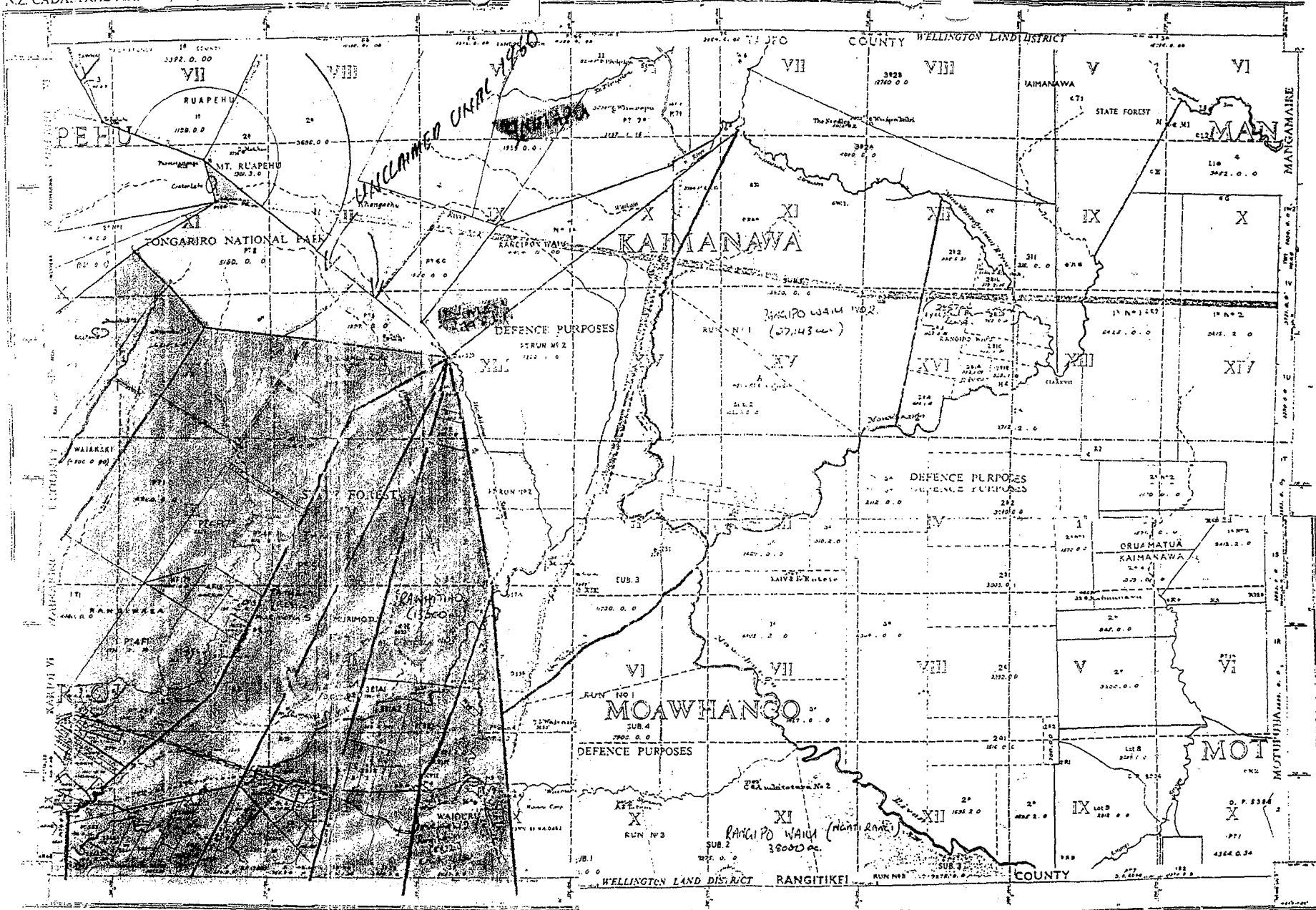

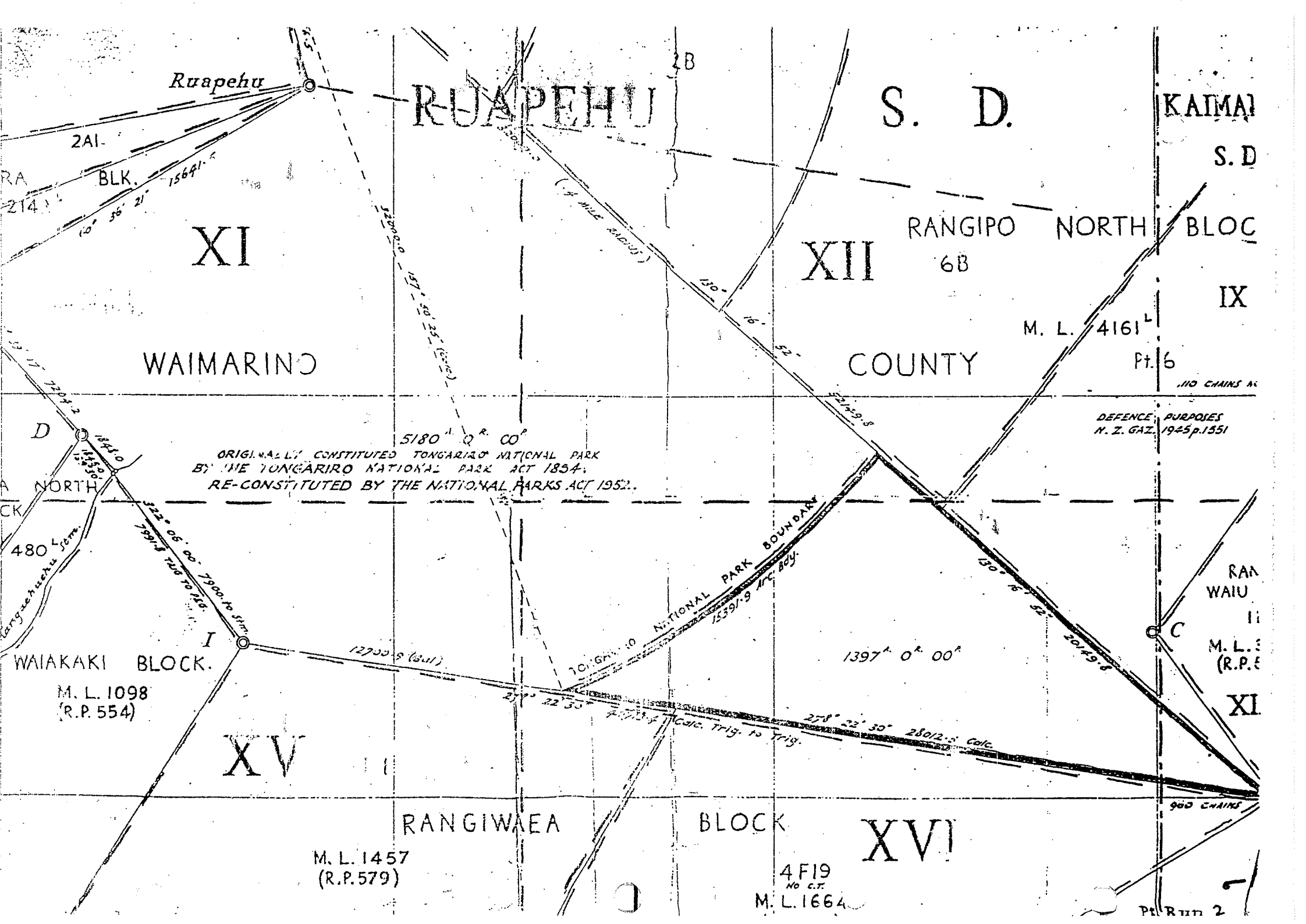
