

Geothermal Resources Inquiry**MEMORANDUM-DIRECTIONS OF THE PRESIDING OFFICER**

1. On 24 May 2013 the Tribunal received a joint memorandum on behalf of the New Zealand Māori Council (NZMC) and Crown Counsel advising that there have been preliminary discussions on a cooperative approach to stage two and the possibility of further refining the stage two issues moving forward (Wai 2358, #3.1.203).
2. On 28 May 2013 I granted leave for counsel to file a further joint memorandum on 28 June 2013 updating the Tribunal on progress and outlining any agreed proposals (Wai 2358, #2.5.38).
3. Today the Tribunal received a memorandum from counsel for the NZMC Felix Geiringer, and Crown counsel Jason Gough (Wai 2358, #3.1.204) advising that while parties have made good progress in their discussions they have been unable to settle on a joint memorandum by 28 June 2013. Counsel now seek leave to file their joint update by 5 July 2013.
4. The leave sought is granted. Counsel are to file their joint memorandum no later than **12pm, Friday 5 July 2013**.

The Registrar is directed to send a copy of this direction to counsel for the claimants, Crown counsel and all those on the distribution list for Wai 2358, the National Fresh Water and Geothermal Resources Inquiry.
