MAY IT PLEASE THE TRIBUNAL

1. This memorandum is filed in response to the directions of the Presiding Officer that cross-examination questions in writing to Dr Grant Young and the documents referred to in support of those questions be filed by 25 October 2013.¹
2. Counsel apologises for the late filing of this memorandum as counsel was busy preparing for Week 7 hearings where those Ngati Te Wehi claimants represented by counsel presented evidence. Accordingly counsel seeks leave to file this memorandum late and respectfully submits that there is no prejudice to any other party.
3. Counsel has been instructed and now advises that questions to be put to Dr Young are no longer necessary. Ngati Te Wehi having presented their evidence during Week 7 are satisfied that their view on those issues to be put to Dr Young have now been properly canvassed and addressed during the presentation of their evidence.
4. Further the documents referred to by counsel during Dr Young's cross-examination in Week 6 hearings are now on the record of inquiry as Wai 898, #N43(a), (b), and (c) as appendices to Boss Mahara's Brief of Evidence.²
