DIRECTION EXTENDING COMMISSIONED RESEARCH

1. Pursuant to clause 5A of the second schedule to the Treaty of Waitangi Act 1975, Craig Innes, a member of the Tribunal's staff, was commissioned on 29 September 2010 to complete a research report on the history of returned lands from the Waikato confiscations for the Te Rohe Pōtae District Inquiry (Wai 898), the deadline for which was 7 January 2011 (Wai 898 #2.3.45).
2. Due to the unforeseen complexity of the research and in order to give parties time to submit feedback, an extension to the deadline for this report has been agreed to.
3. A complete draft of the report was submitted on 17 December 2010 and the commission ends on 21 January 2011, by which date the final report must be presented for filing. The report and any subsequent evidential material based on it must be filed through the Registrar.
