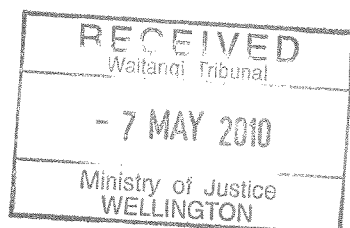

1. Written material from the fourth hui


- 1.1 The fourth ngā kōrero tūku iho hui was held at Ngapūwaiwaha marae in Taumarunui last week. A large amount of helpful material was provided during the hui. There were a number of speakers who referred to material during their kōrero, but who did not file any at the time. Any speaker who wishes to file supplementary material from the fourth hui may do so by **21 May 2010**.
- 1.2 During Ngāti Tūwharetoa's presentation at the fourth hui, Mr Otimi referred to the Te Taumarumarutanga o Ngāti Tūwharetoa traditional and oral history report which was filed in the National Park inquiry (Wai 1130 #G17). A powerpoint presentation and notes were also utilised during this presentation. Karen Feint, counsel for Ngāti Tūwharetoa, will please file a memorandum clarifying whether her clients seek to have this report entered on to the Te Rohe Pōtae district record of inquiry.
- 1.3 I note that a number of speakers referred to various other traditional and oral history reports presented in the Wai 903 Whanganui district inquiry. Those speakers or their counsel are to please file memoranda if they seek to have these reports entered on to the Te Rohe Pōtae district record of inquiry.

2. Extension request for third hui written material

- 2.1 In his memorandum of 29 April 2010, Miharo Armstrong, counsel for speakers from the Whaingaroa hui, seeks an extension to file digital copies of overhead presentations, maps and whakapapa tables for his clients by **21 May 2010**. I grant the leave sought.
