1. This memorandum is filed on behalf of Ngāti Manga-Paretekawa and Ngāti Parewaeono:

 - Wai 1100 (Harriet Chase);
 - Wai 1094 (Ronald Waho and Jean Apaapa);
 - Wai 1136 (Kawhia Te Muraahi and Maehe Muraahi);
 - Wai 1139 (Winifred Rika and Kawhia Te Muraahi);
 - Wai 1099 (Raymond Francis Mokau);
 - Wai 1132 (Winifred Rika and Wiremu Clarke);
 - Wai 1133 (Winifred Rika and Wiremu Clarke).
2. The claimants above have had the opportunity to consider their position following the Judicial Conference held at Te Kuiti on 2 and 3 October 2006. The claimants wish to proceed to a full Tribunal Inquiry.
3. That said the claimants are still of the view and support a process whereby the Tribunal, CFRT and possibly the Office of Treaty Settlements provide information/workshops about the options available to all claimants in the King Country Inquiry.
4. The claimants and Counsel are not yet in a position to make suggestions in regard to existing research that is to be placed on the Record of Inquiry. Counsel submits that this should be an ongoing process over the next 2-4 months prior to the next Judicial Conference.
