CONCERNING the Treaty of Waitangi Act 1975
AND the Te Paparahi o Te Raki Inquiry

DIRECTION EXTENDING COMMISSIONED RESEARCH

1. Pursuant to clause 5A of the second schedule of the Treaty of Waitangi Act 1975, Samuel Carpenter of Rawene was commissioned on 28 April 2009 to prepare a research report on He Whakaputanga and Te Tiriti o Waitangi for the Te Raki inquiry, the deadline for which was 28 September 2009.
2. Mr Carpenter has had to address vital issues, and more time devoted to the analysis of these issues will benefit the inquiry. An extension to the deadline is therefore granted.
3. A complete draft of the report is to be submitted by 19 October 2009 and the commission ends on 16 November 2009, by which date the final report must be presented for filing. The report and any subsequent evidential material based on it must be filed through the Registrar.
