MEMORANDUM-DIRECTIONS OF THE PRESIDING OFFICER

Recently filed memoranda of claimant counsel

1. Recently the Tribunal has received a number of memoranda of claimant counsel seeking leave to file various documents. This memorandum-directions addresses those memoranda.
2. In my memorandum-directions dated 25 June 2010 (Wai 1040, #2.5.41) I granted leave for claimant counsel, Ms Janet Mason and Ms Priscilla Agius, to file Mr Haami Piripi's amended brief of evidence by 2 July 2010. Ms Mason and Ms Agius filed the amended brief on 5 July 2010 with an accompanying memorandum seeking leave to file after the deadline.
3. In my memorandum-directions dated 23 June 2010 (Wai 1040, #2.5.40) I requested that claimant counsel, Mr Charl Hirschfeld, file a translation of Ms Louisa Collier's brief of evidence by 2 July 2010. On 6 July 2010 Mr Hirschfeld filed a memorandum seeking leave to file the translation.
4. The Registrar has requested that claimant counsel, Mr Gerald Sharrock, file a memorandum of counsel seeking to file Rev. Donald Glennie's amended brief of evidence. The Tribunal is yet to receive this memorandum.
5. Claimant counsel, Ms Linda Thornton, filed a memorandum on 9 July 2010 seeking leave for an extension to file Ms Nin Tomas' brief of evidence late.

Directions of the Tribunal

6. I grant leave for Mr Piripi's amended brief to be placed on the record of inquiry for Wai 1040. In light of this extension I grant leave for claimant counsel, Mr Jason Pou, to file his written questions in response by **5pm, Tuesday 13 July 2010**.
7. Leave is also granted for the translation of Ms Collier's brief of evidence to be placed on the record of inquiry for Wai 1040.

8. I grant leave for Ms Thornton to file Ms Tomas' brief of evidence by **5pm, Tuesday 13 July 2010.**
9. I direct Mr Sharrock to file a memorandum of counsel seeking leave to file Rev. Glennie's amended brief of evidence by **5pm, Tuesday 13 July 2010.**
10. I remind counsel that it is usual procedure to seek leave for extension prior to the prescribed deadline. However, in the interest of expediency I grant the leave sought in these cases.

The Registrar is to send this direction to all those on the notification list for Wai 1040, the combined record of inquiry for the Te Paparahi o Te Raki claims.
